#### Older Riders, Alcohol and Motorcycles – A Deadly Mix

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A Presentation to

Lifesavers Conference Austin, TX March 2006

The presentation summarizes a research study conducted by Irwin Broh and Associates for the Motorcycle Safety Foundation. The sample was a nationally projectable sample gathered through a panel study methodology. The survey content included questions about participant demographics, riding frequency, risk factors, and attitudes toward and use of alcohol. The incidence of riding after drinking was measured at less than 10%, but varied for factors such as gender, age, and income. Several MSF programs designed to provide training in the area of alcohol and the seasoned rider are reviewed as a response to the issue of drinking and riding among older riders.


#### Background on Methodology

#### About the NFO Panel (National Family Opinion)

- World's largest consumer panel
  - Almost one million member households in the U.S.
  - Balanced by age, income, ethnicity, census track, etc.
  - Statistical microcosm of U.S. population
- Established in 1946
- Panel membership is free and voluntary

#### > Advantages:

- National probability sample of motorcycle owning households
- Representative of U.S. population
- Results statistically projectable
- Respondents answer anonymously
- Lacks persisting problems of random digit dial method

Impairment Discussion Graphic




