*Graduated Driver Licensing (GDL) laws require young drivers to gain driving experience before obtaining full driving privileges. Typical provisions include required number of hours of supervised driving, restrictions on nighttime driving, carrying passengers, and prohibition on cell phone use/texting. Every state has a graduated licensing system for driver's licensing.

Most programs include three stages:

- Learner Stage: supervised driving, cumulating with a driving test;
- Intermediate Stage: limits unsupervised driving in high risk situations; and
- Full Privilege Stage: regular driver's license.

(7) 21+ may ride without helmet only if covered by insurance policy providing at least \$10,000 in medical benefits.

(8) 21+ may ride without helmet only if they have applicable insurance, and have passed a motorcycle safety course, or have had motorcycle endorsement for at least 2 yrs.

(9) 26+ may ride without helmet only if they have medical insurance and proof of financial responsibility.

(10) 21+ may ride without helmet only if they have two years of riding experience or have completed motorcycle safety course.

(11) And during first year of having motorcycle license.

(12) 21+ may ride without helmet only if they complete motorcycle operator training and safety course or have medical insurance.
